WHAT IS WORKPLACE GIVING?

Workplace giving (WPG)

enables employees to make regular donations to charitable organisations with deductible gift recipient (DGR) status directly from their pre-tax income. The employee simply chooses an amount to donate and the employer deducts the amount from your pay and sends the donation directly to the charity each payday.

What do you need to do?

Simply complete the WPG donation form and pass it on to your payroll office. They will pass on the donation to Dana Asia.
